GeoGeneral

ZIP Code basic data

Field Name	Description
1- City	City name designated by the United States Postal Service
2- CityAliasName	The alias name. This may be a city name, postal entity, community or a municipality name.
3- PopulationEstimate	Estimated household population for the last month. The estimate is derived from known delivery information, household occupancy rates, household size, and more to come up with an accurate estimation for the current population. This data does not include population counts for persons in nursing homes, correctional facilities, or other institutions.
4- CountyName	Applicable county or parish
5- CountyFIPs	Federal Information Processing Standards code for the applicable county
6- Latitude	The geographic coordinate measured in degrees north or south of the equator
7- Longitude	The geographic coordinate measured in degrees east or west of the Greenwich (prime) meridian
8- StateFullName	The full U.S. state or territory name
9- State	2 character state or territory designation
10- AreaCode	The telephone area code(s)
11- StateFIPs	Federal Information Processing Standards code given to each state or territory
12- TimeZone	Federal Information Processing Standards code given to each state or territory
13- Region	A geographic area consisting of several states defined by the U.S. Department of Commerce. The states are grouped into 4 regions.
14- DayLightSaving	Indicates whether daylight savings applies
15- Division	A geographic area consisting of several states defined by the U.S. Department of Commerce. The states are grouped into 9 divisions.
16- LandArea	The approximate amount of land area covered in square miles
17- CBSA	Core Based Statistical Area (replaces MSA's)
18- CBSAName	The name of the Core Based Statistical Area
19- Congressional District	The applicable congressional district
20- CongressionalLandArea	The approximate land area covered by the applicable congressional district
21- CBSAType	Indicates whether a CBSA is a Metropolitan (> 50,000 population) or Micropolitan (10,000 to 50,000 population) Statistical Area

Field Name	Description
1 - City	City name designated by the United States Postal Service
2 - State	2 character state or territory designation
3 - Population	The population from the 2010 Census
4 - DeliveryBusiness	The number of active business delivery mailboxes and centralized units. This excludes PO boxes and all other contract box types.
5 - PopulationEstimate	Estimated household population for the last month. The estimate is derived from known delivery information, household occupancy rates, household size, and more to come up with an accurate estimation for the current population. This data does not include population counts for persons in nursing homes, correctional facilities, or other institutions.
6 - DeliveryResidential	The number of active residential delivery mailboxes and centralized units. This excludes PO boxes and all other contract box types.
7 - DeliveryTotal	The total number of delivery receptacles. This includes curb side mailboxes, centralized units, PO Boxes, NDCBU, and contract boxes. This count is for residential and business combined.
8 - BusinessFirstQuarterPayroll	The first quarter payroll from the most recent Statistics of U.S. Businesses
9 - AverageHouseValue	The average house value from the latest 5-year aggregated American Community Survey
10 - MedianAge	The median age from the 2010 Census
11 - GrowingCountiesA	The estimated number of housing units in the applicable county as of July 1, 2010 according to the US Census
12 - MedianAgeMale	The male median age the 2010 Census
13 - MedianAgeFemale	The female median age from the 2010 Census
14 - GrowthIncreaseNumber	The change in housing units from 2010 to 2011, expressed as a number according to the US Census.
15 - HouseholdsPerZipCode	The number of households from the 2010 Census
16 - GrowthIncreasePercentage	The change in housing units from 2010 to 2011, expressed as a percentage according to the US Census
17 - PersonsPerHousehold	The persons per household from the 2010 Census
18 - IncomePerHousehold	The income per household from the latest 5-year aggregated American Community Survey
19 - CBSAPopulation	The estimated population for the selected CBSA from the 2010 Census
20 - CBSADivisionPopulation	The estimated population for the selected CBSA Division from the 2010 Census
21 - NumberofBusinesses	The total number of business establishments from the most recent Business Census
22 - CBSAName	The name of the Core Based Statistical Area
