

CDXStreamer Online Tools Demographic Data Definitions

Please Note! – Not all zip codes will have population and other US Census data. Zip Codes can be assigned to P.O. Box Only Locations, business and government locations that are not covered and will be assigned a 0 value in the report.

General Report Definitions

City Name - The city name for the zip Code. This may be a city name, postal entity, community or a municipality name.

City Alias Name - Abbreviation of city alias where applicable.

County Name - County or parish where the Zip Code resides.

County FIPS - Federal Information Processing Standards code given to each county.

State Full Name – The full U.S. state or territory name.

State FIPS - Federal Information Processing Standards code given to each state or territory.

Region - A geographic area consisting of several States defined by the U.S. Department of Commerce.

Division - A geographic area consisting of several States defined by the U.S. Department of Commerce. The States are grouped into nine divisions

CBSA Number - Core Based Statistical Area.

CBSA Name - The name of the Core Based Statistical Area.

CBSA Type - Indicates whether a CBSA is Metro (> 50,000 population) or Micro (10,000 to 50,000 population).

Elevation - The county's average elevation.

Population Estimate - The current estimated household population of the Zip Code.

Latitude - The geographic coordinate measured in degrees north or south of the equator.

Longitude - The geographic coordinate measured in degrees east or west of the Greenwich (prime) meridian.

Area Code - Telephone area code(s) of the zip code.

Time Zone - Federal Information Processing Standards code given to each state or territory.

DayLight Savings – Y/N Flag indicating whether this ZIP Code observes daylight savings.

Land Area - The land area of this ZIP Code in Square Miles

Water Area – The water area of this ZIP Code in Square Miles

Congressional District - This field shows which congressional districts the zip code resides in.

Congressional Land Area - This field shows the land area for the districts the zip code resides in.

Demographic Data Items

Population - The population of the Zip Code from the Year 2010 U.S. Census.

Population Estimate - The current estimated household population of the Zip Code.

Business Annual Payroll - The total annual payroll for this ZIP Code from the U.S. Business Census.

Business First Quarter Payroll - The first quarter payroll for this ZIP Code from the U.S. Business Census.

Median Age - The Median Age in the Zip Code the Year 2010 U.S. Census.

Median Age Female - The Female Median Age in the Zip Code from the Year 2010 U.S. Census.

Median Age Male - The Male Median Age in the Zip Code the Year 2010 U.S. Census.

Persons Per Household - The Persons per Household in the Zip Code from the Year 2010 U.S. Census.

IncomePerHousehold - The median household per ZIP Code based on the latest American Community Survey (ACS) data from the U.S. Census.

Number of Businesses - The total number of Business Establishments for this zip Code from the U.S. Business Census.

Number of Employees - The total number of employees for this ZIP Code from the U.S. Business Census.

Delivery Business - This field provides the number of active business delivery mailboxes and centralized units for this ZIP Code.

Delivery Residential - This field provides the number of active residential delivery mailboxes and centralized units for this ZIP Code.

Delivery Total - This field provides the total number of active delivery mailboxes and centralized units for this ZIP Code.

Average House Value - The median house value in the ZIP Code based on the latest American Community Survey (ACS) data from the U.S. Census.

Growing Counties A - The estimated number of housing units in this county as of July 1, 2010. Source: Population Division, U.S. Census. Bureau.

Growing Counties B - The estimated number of housing units in this county as of July 1, 2011. Source: Population Division, U.S. Census. Bureau

Growth Increase Number - The change in housing units from 2003 to 2004, expressed as a number according to the US Census.

Growth Increase Percentage - The change in housing units from 2010 to 2011, expressed as a percentage according to the US Census.

Growth Rank - The growth rank for this county according to the US Census.

CBSA Population - The estimated population for the selected CBSA in 2010.

CBSA Division Population - The estimated population for the selected CBSA Division in 2010.

CBSA Division - Core Based Statistical Area Division name

Gender Report Definitions

Male Population - The Male population in the Zip Code from the Year 2010 U.S. Census.

Female Population - The Female population in the Zip Code from the Year 2010 U.S. Census.

Race Report Definitions

Asian Population - The Asian population in the Zip Code from the Year 2010 U.S. Census.

Black Population - The Black population in the Zip Code from the Year 2010 U.S. Census.

Indian Population - The American Indian and Alaska Native population in the Zip Code from the Year 2010 U.S. Census.

Hawaiian Population - The Hawaiian population in the Zip Code from the Year 2010 U.S. Census.

White Population – The white population in the Zip Code from the Year 2010 U.S. Census

Other Population - The non classified population in the Zip Code from the Year 2010 U.S. Census.
